The Technion Industry Liaison Program (TILP) was established by the Technion in response to the current accelerated pace of technological transformation. TILP enables a company to navigate the Technion's resources and establish a direct line of communication with Technion researchers in relevant fields.

"TILP expands interactions between Technion and Industry, allowing member companies access to cutting edge developments in their fields."

The Technion has set to improve and expand reciprocal two-way interactions with industry. A password-protected members-only website was developed, where researchers in search of funding are encouraged to upload descriptions of their work (without revealing confidential information). The website also features presentations on interesting Technion research. TILP members gain access to the site at no additional charge and can browse it, searching for areas of interest, and then arrange further contact with the researchers via their Technion PoC.
